

## **Foreigner working in Norway?**

According to Norwegian health legislation, persons working in Norway for more than 3 months, are obliged to undergo examination for tuberculosis if they come from the following countries:

### **Europe and central Asia:**

Bosnia-Herzegovina, Greenland, Kosovo, Romania and all countries of former USSR: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kirgiztan, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, Russia, Tadjikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine and Uzbekistan.

### **America:**

Belize, Bolivia, Brazil, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Guatemala, Guyana, Haiti, Honduras and Nicaragua

### **Oceania:**

Marshall Islands, Guam, Kiribati, Micronesia, Palau, Papua New-Guinea, Salomon Islands, Tuvalu and Vanuatu.

### **Asia:**

Middle East: Iraq and Yemen. Rest of Asia: All countries except Japan, Singapore and Maldives

### **Afrika:**

All countries except Mauritius, Comoros and Seychelles.

Here in Ulvik, Eidfjord or Granvin you must contact the Public Health Office (doctor or public health nurse) for examination as soon as possible after arrival.

- Standard procedure for people under 40 years of age (15-40) is a chest X-ray and a blood sample.
- For persons older than 40 years of age the standard is only a chest X-ray
- If you bring younger children with you (under the age of 15), they must take the skin test (Mantoux)
