

Foreigner working in Norway?

According to Norwegian health legislation, persons working in Norway for more than 3 months, are obliged to undergo examination for tuberculosis if they come from the following countries:

Here in Ulvik, you must contact the Public Health Office (doctor or public health nurse) for examination as soon as possible after arrival.

- Standard procedure for people under 40 years of age (15-40) is a chest X-ray and a blood sample.
- For persons older than 40 years of age the standard is only a chest X-ray
- If you bring younger children with you (under the age of 15), they must take the skin test (Mantoux)
